Tips for Executives & Professionals:

- Match the tool to your task—don't "over-AI." For simple answers, stick to ChatGPT or Gemini; for big decisions, use analytics like ThoughtSpot.
- Automate repetitive work (scheduling, note conversion, email sorting) with Copilot or Reclaim.ai to free up strategic time.
- Use privacy-focused options (DeepSeek, LLaMA) for sensitive negotiations or executive communication.
- Leverage multilingual tools (LLaMA, Qwen) for global teams or international expansion.
- Stay aware of the tech's limits—Al is great for structure, summary, and routine, but still needs human judgment for strategy and empathy.
